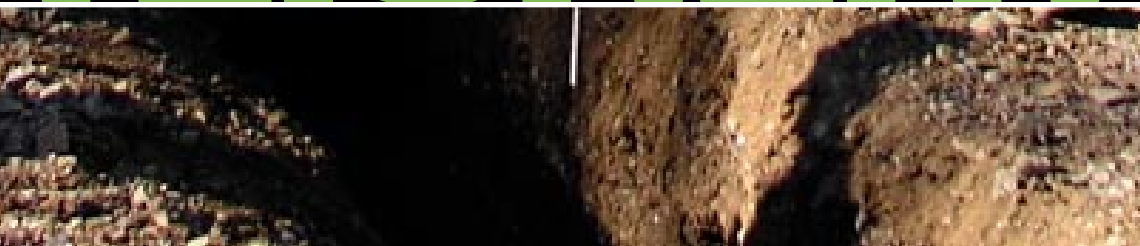


**TEICHERT**

As our communities continue to grow, Teichert and our family of operations will be there when it all happens, just as we have been since 1887.

Adolph Teichert immigrated to New York from Germany in 1866 and subsequently was recruited by the California Artificial Stone Paving Company in the 1870's.

Some of his early work remains in San Francisco's Golden Gate Park and near the Mark Hopkins Hotel, having survived both the 1906 earthquake and more than a century of use.

He migrated to Sacramento to work on laying the sidewalks around the original State Capitol building, and he then opened his own business in 1887 by building walkways, cellar floors, sidewalks, fencing, and other projects.

Adolph was joined in the company by one of his four children, Adolph Jr., and the two of them grew the business.

Teichert is still family owned and operated today.

Teichert continues to adhere to the basic principles of Adolph Teichert: Employees are like family – treat them that way and you will do well. Give back to your community. Be fair with your customers because they deserve it. And, never let go of your integrity.

Henry Teichert, grandson of the founder, started the company's Safety Program in 1959 – long before the Occupational Safety and Health Administration was founded in 1970. Our emphasis on safe production practices has continued to grow significantly, and it remains our top priority.

Our construction materials businesses include: Teichert Aggregates, a rock, sand, gravel, and asphaltic concrete producer; Teichert Readymix, a ready mixed concrete producer; and Teichert Precast Products, a precast concrete manufacturer. Teichert Materials makes the materials to build homes, schools, offices, roads, levees, and other community projects.

The business units in Teichert Materials differentiate themselves through a strong focus on the customer. We deliver best-in-market customer service and product quality through safe production. We also pride ourselves by producing and delivering our products on time and in specification.

A portion of a former mining site was converted to usable land for Rosemont High School, a retention basin, separation berm, and housing development.

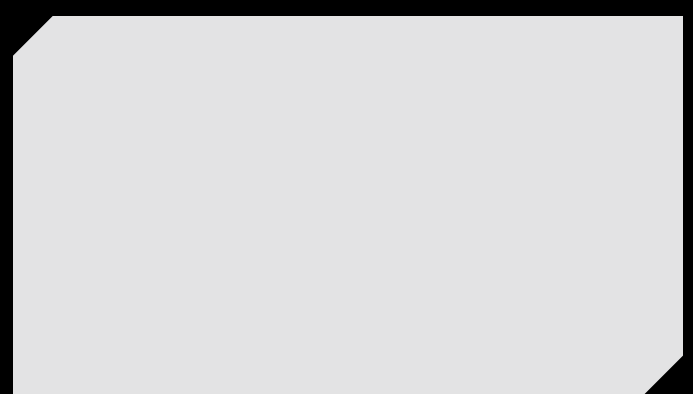


Shown here are participants in the Adventure-Risk-Challenge Summer Literacy & Leadership Program near Truckee, supported by Teichert Foundation.
